# **Checklist for MD/MPH Students**

Meet with your advisor <b>EVERY</b> semester before you register for courses.
<ul> <li>Register <u>EVERY</u> semester you are in the Program in Applied Public Health Sciences (MPH).</li> <li>If you are not registering for an MPH course, you still need to register for Continuous Registration. Ask Holly Samociuk, if you have any questions.</li> </ul>
Fill out the Tuition Aid Application and send to Holly Samociuk <u>EVERY</u> Semester.  • You can get the form from Holly Samociuk.

### When taking a Leave of Absence (LOA) from the Medical School to pursue MPH coursework:

- Tuition is paid by the Program in Applied Public Health Sciences (MPH).
- Fees are the **student's responsibility.**

### When full time in Medical School AND enrolled in Graduate (MPH) coursework:

- Medical School tuition and fees are the student's responsibility.
- Grad school tuition and fees will not be charged.

#### When full time in Medical School and <u>NOT</u> registering for Graduate (MPH) coursework:

- Students <u>must</u> also register for Continuous Registration with the Graduate School.
- Continuous Registration fees will not be charged.
